On June 30, 2017, The Empire District Electric Company, The Empire District Gas Company, Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp., and Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water) LLC, all subsidiaries of Algonquin Power & Utilities Corp., filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking approval of their Cost Allocation Manual.

The Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG), an incorporated entity representing the interests of large commercial and industrial users of electricity and natural gas throughout Missouri, including the area served by Empire, applied to intervene on July 10. More than ten days have passed since MECG applied to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

The Commission finds that MECG's interest in this case differs from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing MECG to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant MECG's application to intervene.

1. The Application to Intervene of the Midwest Energy Consumers Group is

granted.
