During preparation for hearing, I identified an error in the calculation of remaining life and age at final retirement shown in Tables 3-4 and 3-5 of Schedule LWL-E1. Specifically, the "Remaining Life" shown in Column I and the "Age at Final Retirement" shown in Column K are over stated by one year. This error resulted because the values were calculated from January 1, 2008 instead of from December 31, 2008 (or January 1, 2009). This error does not affect my conclusion, as to the estimated retirement dates (shown in Column G of Table 3-5). However, I use the figures affected several places in my testimony and in Schedule LWL-E1. The following lists the specific references that are in error and the correction required.

## Direct Testimony

Page 8, Line 11 - "from 67 to 73 years." s/b "from 66 to 72 years."
Page 8, Line 11 - "from 62 to 73 years." $s / b$ "from 61 to 72 years."

## Schedule LWL-E1

Page 1-1, Section 1.2, $1^{\text {st }}$ Paragraph, $5^{\text {th }}$ Line - "nominally 62 to 73 years." $s / b$ "nominally 61 to 72 years."

Page 1-3, Table 1-1-All values shown in the final column ("Age") $\mathrm{s} / \mathrm{b}$ decreased by one
Page 1-3, $1^{\text {st }}$ line of text - "of 65 to 73 years." $\mathrm{s} / \mathrm{b}$ "of 64 to 72 years."
Page 3-4, final paragraph, 3 rd line - "nominally 62 to 71 years." $s / b$ "nominally 61 to 70 years."

Page 3-5, Table 3-4 - All values shown in Column I ("Recommended Remaining Life") s/b decreased by one

Page 3-5, Table 3-4 - All values shown in Column K ("Age at Final Retirement") s/b decreased by one
