## **ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF LACLEDE GAS COMPANY**

On July 24, 2009, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, filed a tariff designed to increase its annual revenues for electric service. The Commission suspended that tariff and established August 17 as the deadline for interested parties to apply to intervene.

Laclede Gas Company applied to intervene on August 10. Laclede is a gas corporation and distributes and sells natural gas to customers in eastern Missouri. More than ten days have passed since Laclede applied to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

The Commission finds that the interest of Laclede in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing Laclede to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Application to Intervene of Laclede Gas Company is granted.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
