**OBJECTION OF AARP
TO NON-UNANIMOUS STIPULATION**

COMES NOW AARP, pursuant to Rule 4 CSR 240-2.115(2), and lodges its Objection to the "Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement Regarding Class Kilowatt-Hours, Revenues and Billing Determinants, Net Base Energy Costs, and Fuel Adjustment Clause Tariff Sheets" ("Non-Unanimous Stipulation"), filed by Ameren Missouri and other parties on November 2, 2012. The Non-unanimous Stipulation proposes joint positions that include a resolution of all Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC") issues, other than the FAC sharing mechanism issue. AARP proposes that the Public Service Commission ("Commission") reject any FAC in this case, and thus specifically objects to the Non-unanimous Stipulation in that it assumes that a Fuel Adjustment Clause will be approved in this case.

AARP does not request any additional hearings regarding the Non-unanimous Stipulation, other than the evidentiary hearing that has already been held regarding FAC issues in this matter.


