ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING AN INTERVENTION DEADLINE, AND DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A PLEADING

On September 12, 2024, MRG Utilities, LLC (MRG) filed the abovereferenced applications. The applications seek authority for MRG to own, operate, maintain, control and manage water and sewer systems in Stone County, Missouri. MRG requests a waiver of Commission Rules 20 CSR 4240-3.305(1)(A)5 and 20 CSR 4240-3.600(1)(A)5, which require a feasibility study. MRG states that no such study is needed because the systems have already been constructed and are operating. MRG also requests a waiver of the 60-day notice provision of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017.

The Commission will direct notice of the application be given to the county commission and local media serving residents of Stone County, Missouri. The Commission will also set a deadline for interested parties to intervene and direct the Staff of the Commission to file a pleading stating when it can file a recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Stone County, Missouri.

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Division shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Stone County, Missouri.

3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene, no later than October 4, 2024. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) or with the Secretary of the Commission. Comments on the application can also be made in EFIS.

4. No later than September 27, 2024, the Commission's Staff shall file a pleading indicating when it can file a recommendation about MRG's application.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
