## ORDER APPROVING INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

Issue Date: August 23, 2019

Effective Date: September 22, 2019

This order approves the Commercial Mobile Radio Services Interconnection Agreement executed by the parties and filed by Embarq Missouri, LLC d/b/a CenturyLink (CenturyLink).

On July 17, 2019, CenturyLink filed an application with the Commission for approval of an Interconnection Agreement with CSC Wireless, LLC d/b/a Altice Mobile (Altice Mobile). The Agreement was filed pursuant to Section 252(e)(1) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.<sup>1</sup> CenturyLink holds a certificate of service authority or is registered to provide local exchange telecommunications services in Missouri. Altice Mobile is a wireless telecommunications company not regulated by the Commission.

Although Altice Mobile is a party to the Agreement, it did not join in the application. On July 17, 2019, the Commission issued an order making Altice Mobile a party in this case and directing any party wishing to request a hearing to do so no later than August 1, 2019. No requests for hearing were filed.

The Staff of the Commission filed a memorandum and recommendation on August 14, 2019, recommending that the Agreement be approved.

### **Discussion**

Under Section 252(e) of the Act, any interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation must be submitted to the Commission for approval. The Commission may reject an agreement if it finds that the agreement is discriminatory or that it is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Staff recommends that the Agreement be approved and notes that the Agreement meets the limited requirements of the Act in that it is not discriminatory toward nonparties and is not against the public interest. Staff recommends that the Commission direct the parties to submit any amendments to the Commission for approval.

### **Findings of Fact**

The Commission has considered the application, the supporting documentation, and Staff's verified recommendation. Based upon that review, the Commission finds that the Agreement meets the requirements of the Act in that it does not discriminate against a nonparty carrier and implementation of the Agreement is not inconsistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. The Commission finds that approval of the Agreement shall be conditioned upon the parties submitting any amendments to the Commission for approval pursuant to the procedure set out below.

### **Amendment Procedure**

The Commission has a duty to review all interconnection agreements, whether arrived at through negotiation or arbitration, as mandated by the Act.<sup>2</sup> In order for the

Commission's role of review and approval to be effective, the Commission must also review and approve or recognize amendments to these agreements. The Commission has a further duty to make a copy of every interconnection agreement available for public inspection.<sup>3</sup>

The parties to each interconnection agreement must maintain a complete and current copy of the agreement, together with all amendments, in the Commission's offices. Any proposed amendment must be submitted pursuant to Commission rules 4 CSR 240-28.020(5) and 4 CSR 240-28.080.

### **Conclusions of Law**

The Commission, under the provisions of Section 252(e)(1) of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996,<sup>4</sup> is required to review negotiated interconnection agreements. It may only reject a negotiated agreement upon a finding that its implementation would be discriminatory to a nonparty or inconsistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.<sup>5</sup> Based upon its review of the Agreement between CenturyLink and Altice Mobile and its findings of fact, the Commission concludes that the Agreement is neither discriminatory nor inconsistent with the public interest and shall be approved.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commercial Mobile Radio Services Interconnection Agreement between Embarq Missouri, LLC d/b/a CenturyLink and CSC Wireless, LLC d/b/a Altice Mobile, filed on July 17, 2019, is approved.

2. Any changes or amendments to this Agreement shall be submitted in compliance with 4 CSR 240-28.020(5) and 4 CSR 240-28.080.
3. This order shall become effective on September 22, 2019.


