Title 20—DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND INSURANCE Division 4240—Public Service Commission Chapter 20—Electric Utilities

PROPOSED RESCISSION

20 CSR 4240-20.015 Affiliate Transactions. This rule was intended to prevent regulated utilities from subsidizing their nonregulated operations. In order to accomplish this objective, the rule set forth financial standards, evidentiary standards and record keeping requirements applicable to any Missouri Public Service Commission (commission) regulated gas corporation whenever such corporation participated in transactions with any affiliated entity (except with regard to HVAC services as defined in section 386.754, RSMo). The rule and its effective enforcement provided the public the assurance that their rates were not adversely impacted by the utilities' nonregulated activities.

PURPOSE: This rule is being rescinded from Chapter 20, as it is being rewritten, and moved to 20 CSR 4240-10.

AUTHORITY: sections 386.250, RSMo Supp. 1998 and 393.140, RSMo 1994.* This rule originally filed as 4 CSR 240-20.015. Original rule filed April 26, 1999, effective Feb. 29, 2000. Moved to 20 CSR 4240-20.015, effective Aug. 28, 2019. Rescinded: Filed ______, effective _____.

*Original authority: 386.250, RSMo 1963, amended 1967, 1977, 1980, 1987, 1988, 1991, 1993, 1995, 1996 and 393.140, RSMo 1939, amended 1949, 1967.

PUBLIC COST: This proposed rescission will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

PRIVATE COST: This proposed rescission will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

NOTICE TO SUBMIT COMMENTS AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING: Anyone may file comments in support of or in opposition to this proposed rescission with the Missouri Public Service Commission, Nancy Dippell, Secretary of the Commission, P.O. A public hearing regarding this proposed rescission is scheduled for December 6, 2024, at 10:00 a.m., in Room 139 of the James C. Kirkpatrick Building, 600 W. Main St., Jefferson City, Missouri. Interested persons may appear at this hearing to submit additional comments and/or testimony in support or in opposition to this proposed rescission, and may be asked to respond to commission questions.
