**ORDER APPOINTING AND RECOGNIZING NEW MEMBERS OF THE
RELAY MISSOURI ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

Effective Date: October 19, 2024

On September 27, 2024, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to approve the appointment of one new member and to approve and recognize one new member to the Relay Missouri Advisory Committee.

Staff explained that the Relay Missouri Advisory Committee was created by this Commission to assist in providing effective dual party relay services in Missouri. The Committee is made up of five permanent members and eight term-limited members. Term-limited members serve three-year terms. Upon the expiration of a term-limited member's tenure, they may request to serve another term, up to three terms total. New members are appointed by the Commission. The members of the Committee also vote to have one member serve as chair of the Committee for that individual's tenure.

Staff explains that the Committee voted for Amanda Whyrick to fill the role as a three-year term limited At-Large member and asks that the Commission make the appointment. The Commission will make the requested appointment.

The Dual Party Relay Service (DPRS) Contractor member for T-Mobile is one of the five permanent member positions on the Committee. On July 1, 2024, Melissa (Missy)

McManus replaced Catherine Macfee as the new contractor for T-Mobile in Missouri. Staff explains that under the Committee bylaws a vote by the Committee is not necessary for this permanent member change but it is contemplated that the Commission will recognize the appointment. Therefore, the Committee requests that the Commission approve and recognize Melissa (“Missy”) McManus as the DPRS Contractor member for T-Mobile. The Commission will grant the request.

So that the appointment and approval and recognition will take effect as soon as possible, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than 30 days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Amanda Whyrick is appointed to the Relay Missouri Advisory Committee as a three-year term limited At-Large member.
2. The Commission recognizes and approves Melissa (Missy) McManus, contractor for T-Mobile in Missouri, to fill the permanent Dual Party Relay Service (DPRS) Contractor member for T-Mobile position on the Relay Missouri Advisory Committee.
3. This order shall become effective on October 19, 2024.
4. This file shall be closed October 20, 2024.
