### ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION

On November 20, 2019, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion requesting that the Commission cancel the certificate of interexchange service authority and interconnected voice over internet protocol (IVoIP) registration of CallCatchers, Inc. d/b/a Freedom Voice Systems (Company) in the State of Missouri. On July 5, 2016, the Commission granted the Company both a certificate to provide intrastate interexchange service in Case No. XA-2016-0351; and registration to provide IVoIP services in Case No. DA-2016-0352. The Staff's motion states that the Company wishes to voluntarily relinquish its authority.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.
