## ORDER STAYING PROCEEDING

The Empire District Electric Company, The Empire District Gas Company, Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp., and Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water) LLC, all subsidiaries of Algonquin Power & Utilities Corp. (jointly Empire), filed an application with the Commission on June 30, 2017, seeking approval of their Cost Allocation Manual (CAM). The parties have continued to negotiate the terms of such CAM and on December 30, 2019, filed a status report and joint motion asking the Commission to stay proceedings in this case.<sup>1</sup>

The joint motion explains that the parties continue to discuss the terms of the CAM in light of possible revisions of the Commission's affiliate transactions rules. The parties agree that revisions to the CAM cannot be finalized until revisions of the rules are promulgated.<sup>2</sup> Therefore, the parties ask the Commission to stay further proceedings in this file until revisions to the affiliate transaction rules have been completed. The Commission will grant that motion.
