The Commission opened this working case in 2010 to facilitate Staff's review of the Commission's rules regarding fuel adjustment clauses. On December 16, 2014, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, Kansas City Power & Light Company, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, and The Empire District Electric Company jointly filed a proposal asking the Commission to establish a timeline for completion of Staff's review of those rules and to allow time for stakeholders to respond to Staff's proposals.

Before considering the joint proposal, the Commission will afford the other stakeholders an opportunity to respond.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any stakeholder wishing to respond to the Joint Proposal of the Electrical Corporations for Completing the Commission's Review of the Fuel Adjustment Clause Rules shall do so no later than December 23, 2014.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
