On March 17, 2014, The Empire District Electric Company, Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed a Joint Motion to Extend Time for Filing. Thus, the movants state that Commission should extend the deadline for filing comments to July 1 so that those FERC docket developments may be considered when the movants file comments in this file.
