NOTICE REGARDING MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION

Issue Date: February 4, 2025

On January 28, 2025, the Commission issued its *Order Granting Motion to Submit Direct Testimony and Directing Staff Recommendation* (Order), allowing the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. (MISO) to submit the direct testimony of witness Jeremiah Doner in support of the application of Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois in this matter.

On January 29, 2025, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a *Motion for Clarification*, requesting the Commission state its basis for its finding of good cause to allow MISO to submit the direct testimony.

The Commission’s basis for its finding of good cause is contained within the body of the Order as follows:

The Commission finds that [allowing MISO to submit direct testimony] will cause no harm or prejudice to the parties and will add efficiency to the proceedings by allowing parties to consider the MISO direct testimony in [Commission] Staff’s recommendation and any rebuttal testimony.
