### Notice of Dismissal

- 1. On September 12, 2024 MRG Utilities, LLC ("MRG") filed its applications seeking permission, approval, and a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to own, operate, maintain, control and manage certain existing water and sewer systems as a regulated utility.
- 2. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.116(1) provides "an applicant or complainant may voluntarily dismiss an application or complaint without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission."
- 3. No testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered in this docket. The Commission previously ordered its staff to file a recommendation on the CCN application by March 3, 2025.
- 4. At this time, having determined it will no longer seek to operate these systems as a regulated utility, MRG files this *Notice of Dismissal*, asks that the staff be relieved of its obligation to prepare and file a recommendation, and asks that the docket be closed.
