### **ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND**

Issue Date: March 3, 2025 Effective Date: March 3, 2025 On February 24, 2025, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a motion requesting that the Commission cancel the certificate of payphone service authority of Jaroth, Inc. d/b/a Pacific Telemanagement Services. The Commission granted Pacific Telemanagement Services a certificate to provide payphone services in File No. PA-2003-0377.

The requirements of telecommunication companies under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-28.012(1)(B) and Section 386.370, RSMo, (2016)<sup>1</sup> include filing a Statement of Revenue and paying the Missouri Commission assessment. Staff's motion states that Pacific Telemanagement Services failed to file its Statement of Revenue report and pay the Missouri Commission annual assessment for fiscal years 2020 through 2025.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which provides "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>2</sup> Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may revoke the certificate of service authority based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to respond or file a motion for hearing.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Anyone wishing to respond to Staff's Motion or request a hearing shall do so by filing an appropriate pleading no later than March 13, 2025.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
