### ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF FILING

On November 27, 2017, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") filed an application requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission approve a tariff authorizing the Renewable Choice Program, which is a new service in which qualifying customers can elect to participate in a subscription-based renewable energy program. Ameren Missouri filed tariff sheets to implement the Renewable Choice Program under Tariff Tracking No. YE-2018-0064. Ameren Missouri extended the effective date of those tariff sheets until April 25, 2018 in order for the parties to conduct negotiations concerning issues raised by Ameren Missouri's application and tariff.

On April 13, 2018, Ameren Missouri filed on behalf of itself and other signatory parties a Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement ("Agreement"), purporting to resolve all issues in this case. Three parties did not sign the Agreement, but the Agreement states that those three parties have indicated they will not oppose it. The Agreement contains an attached exhibit consisting of new tariff sheets that are intended to replace the previously-filed tariff sheets if the Commission approves the Agreement.

Under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.115(2), the three parties that did not sign the

Agreement have until April 20, 2018 to file an objection to the Agreement. If no objections

are filed, the Commission may treat the Agreement as unanimous and approve the

Agreement. The next scheduled public agenda meeting after April 20, 2018 at which the

Commission may take up and consider the Agreement for approval is April 25, 2018.

However, the existing tariff will have gone into effect by operation of law on midnight of

April 25, 2018, prior to the Commission's scheduled public meeting later that day.

Since the Agreement represents that all parties either support or do not oppose the

Agreement and that the signatory parties intend for the tariff sheets attached to the

Agreement to replace the previously-filed tariff, the Commission will suspend the existing

filed tariff sheets for an additional thirty days so that they do not go into effect before the

Commission has an opportunity to consider whether to approve the Agreement and finally

resolve all of the issues in this matter.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff submitted under Tariff File No. YE-2018-0064 by Union Electric

Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, effective on April 25, 2018, is suspended until May 25,

2018.

2. The specific tariff sheets suspended are:

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### 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
