ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND

On February 24, 2025, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a motion requesting that the Commission cancel the registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol (IVoIP) service of Pareteum Corporation. The Commission granted Pareteum Corporation registration to provide IVoIP service in File No. DA-2022-0251.

The requirements of telecommunication companies under Sections 392.210, 392.390, and 386.370 RSMo (2016)¹, and Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-28.012(1)(B) include filing an annual report, filing a Statement of Revenue, and paying the Missouri Commission assessment. Staff's motion states that Pareteum Corporation failed to submit an annual report to the Missouri Commission for calendar years 2022 and 2023. Staff's motion also states that Pareteum Corporation failed to file its Statement of Revenue report and pay the Missouri Commission annual assessment for fiscal years 2024 and 2025.

Section 392.410(5), RSMo, provides the Commission authority to alter or modify any telecommunications certificate of service after notice and hearing.

¹ All statutory references are to those published in 2016 unless otherwise indicated.

Section 392.550(4), RSMo, provides that the Commission may revoke an IVoIP registration for failure to comply with the requirements of Section 392.550, RSMo.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.² Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may revoke the registration based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to respond or file a motion for hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Anyone wishing to respond to Staff's Motion or request a hearing shall do so by filing an appropriate pleading no later than March 7, 2025.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
