On March 31, 2025,¹ the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a *Motion Requesting Local Public Hearings and for Expedited Treatment* (Motion). The ten days for parties to respond to the Motion extends beyond the date requested for an order. Accordingly, the time for responses to the Motion will be shortened.

1. Any responses to the Motion must be filed no later than 10:00 a.m. on April 3, 2025.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
