ORDER EXTENDING DATE FOR STAFF TO FILE PROPOSED RULE AMENDMENTS

The Commission opened this working case on October 10, 2013, to facilitate Staff's efforts to obtain input from interested stakeholders regarding the drafting of a modified rule concerning renewable energy standard requirements and net metering standards. In its order creating this case, the Commission directed Staff to present proposed rule amendments to the Commission for consideration no later than April 8, 2014.

On March 13, 2014, Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri, acting on behalf of the Missouri Solar Energy Industries Association (MOSEIA), Wind on the Wires, and Brightergy, LLC, filed a motion asking the Commission to extend the deadline for Staff's submission of proposed rule amendments until May 15, 2014. The movants explain that discussions about the proposed amendments are still proceeding and would be assisted by an additional workshop. The movants represent that Staff, The Missouri Division of Energy, the Office of the Public Counsel, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, Kansas City Power & Light Company, The Empire District Electric

Company and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) do not oppose the request for more time to discuss the proposed amendments.

The Commission finds that the request for more discussion is reasonable and will extend the time for Staff to file proposed rule amendments.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The time allowed for Staff to present proposed rule amendments to the Commission for consideration is extended from April 8, 2014 to May 15, 2014.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
