- b. What is the appropriate current annual amount for Ameren Missouri's ratepayers to contribute to Ameren Missouri's Callaway Energy Center Nuclear Decommissioning Trust Fund (inclusive of the Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation) for that fund to have neither greater nor lesser than the amount necessary to carry out the decommissioning of Callaway Unit 1 and the

Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation at the end of the NRC Callaway Unit 1 license life—presently October 18, 2044?

2. Contested Issues:

- a. Is it reasonable for the trustee to continue to maintain a trust fund asset allocation of 65% equities and 35% bonds when the trust balance is currently sufficient to cover the estimated decommissioning costs in the most recent triennial filing?
- b. Is it reasonable for the Commission to approve a customer contribution cost trigger of \$50 million before the company can request to resume customer contributions to the fund in a future triennial filing?
