1           The following proceedings began at 6:20 p.m.:

2                   JUDGE PRIDGIN: Excuse me. Good evening.  
3 This is the local public hearing for File Number  
4 GR-2024-0369.

5                   Missouri Public Service Commission  
6 regulates the rates charged by investor-owned utility  
7 companies in Missouri to ensure that those rates are  
8 just and reasonable. The Commission also regulates  
9 the quality of service and safety of the operations of  
10 those investor-owned utilities.

11                   The Commission is made up of four  
12 Commissioners; three of whom are with me this evening  
13 in person, one on the WebEx call. These Commissioners  
14 are appointed by the Governor to fixed terms and  
15 confirmed by the Senate. The Commissioners employ a  
16 staff of engineers, accountants, attorneys, financial  
17 analysts and other specialists in the field of utility  
18 regulation.

19                   I am Ron Pridgin. I am a Regulatory Law  
20 Judge for the Missouri Public Service Commission and I  
21 will preside over this hearing. With me from my left  
22 to my right is Commissioner Coleman, Chair Hahn, and  
23 Commissioner Kolkmeyer.

24                   Before I forget, let me get entries of  
25 appearance from counsel, please, beginning with the

1 company.

2 MS. HERNANDEZ: Jennifer Hernandez  
3 appearing on behalf of Ameren Missouri. Our address  
4 is 1901 Chouteau Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri 63166.

5 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Ms. Hernandez, thank you.  
6 Any entry on behalf of the Staff of the  
7 Commission, please?

8 MR. STACEY: Scott Stacey representing  
9 the Staff. Address is 200 Madison Street, Jefferson  
10 City, 65101.

11 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Stacey, thank you.  
12 On behalf of the Office of the Public  
13 Counsel, please?

14 MS. MARTIN: Hi. My name is Anna Martin.  
15 I am an associate attorney that is representing the  
16 Office of the Public Counsel. And I believe that our  
17 address is on record.

18 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Ms. Martin, thank you.  
19 Any other counsel wishing to enter an  
20 appearance?

21 All right. Hearing none, this is an  
22 official hearing of the Missouri Public Service  
23 Commission. Statements and testimony of witnesses  
24 will be recorded by the court reporter and must be  
25 given under oath. All the Commissioners will have the

1 chance to read your remarks.

2           The purpose of this hearing this evening  
3 is to hear from you. The Company will not present  
4 witnesses and will not answer questions during this  
5 hearing. This is your chance to testify and your  
6 remarks will be made a part of the official record of  
7 this case.

8           I do not believe at this point that we  
9 have had anybody sign up to testify, but let me double  
10 check. Does anyone wish to testify before the  
11 Commission this evening? Going once, going twice.

12           Hearing no one wishing to testify, does  
13 anything -- excuse me. Does anybody from the Bench  
14 have any remarks for the audience before we conclude?

15           CHAIR HAHN: Sure, Judge.

16           Thank you everyone for being here. I  
17 know that we didn't have anyone from the public  
18 testify this evening, but if there is anyone in the  
19 audience that is still interested in providing  
20 comments, we can certainly take your comments and put  
21 them in the public record.

22           So they're -- I think the Judge can give  
23 instructions on how to do that just in case there --  
24 there are comments that folks would like to provide.  
25 We do take public comment very seriously and so we

1 want to make sure we consider all of the comments when  
2 we make a final determination in the case.

3 And I know that it is no small feat for  
4 folks to put on events like this to make sure that the  
5 public is heard, and so just appreciate everyone  
6 making this event happen. Thank you all so much.

7 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Chair Hahn, thank you.


8 Anything else before we go off the
