ORDER GRANTING STAFF MOTION TO EXTEND DATE FOR FILING STAFF'S RECOMMENDED RULE REVISION

The Commission opened this file to facilitate Staff's efforts to gather input from interested stakeholders about the drafting of a revision of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.105. That rule sets out the filing requirements for electric utilities seeking a certificate of convenience and necessity. In a previous order, the Commission directed Staff to prepare and present a revised rule to the Commission by December 19, 2014.

On December 5, Staff filed a motion explaining that it has conducted two workshops with stakeholders to discuss possible revisions to the rule. Staff indicates a third workshop would be helpful, but more time is needed to allow for the scheduling of that workshop. For that reason, Staff asks the Commission to extend the deadline for presenting a revised rule until February 20, 2015. Staff's motion represents that Staff has contacted counsel for stakeholders and that those stakeholders do not object to the proposed delay.

The Commission will extend the time allowed for Staff to file its proposed rule to allow more time to collect input from stakeholders.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The time allowed for Staff to prepare and present a revised rule to the Commission is extended until February 20, 2015.

- 2. Staff may schedule the dates for submission of written responses and for the holding of a workshop as it sees fit to gather the information it desires so as to comply with the revised deadline.
 - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
