#### **APPLICATION**

Comes now TBJ Sewer System Inc. (hereinafter "TBJ" or "Applicant") and pursuant to §393.170, RSMo 2000 and 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(A), and states to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a Missouri corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Missouri with its principal office and place of business located at 5686 Gildehaus Road, Village Ridge, Missouri 63089. TBJ currently provides sewer service to members of the public located in an unincorporated area of Franklin County, Missouri and, accordingly, is subject to the jurisdiction, control and regulation of the Commission as provided by law.

- 3. Applicant previously applied for and received a certificate of convenience and necessity from the Commission to provide service in its existing service territory in Commission Case No. SA-97-441. A copy of the Commission's October 29, 1997 Order Approving Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in that case is attached hereto as Appendix 1.
- 4. Applicant requests permission, approval and a certificate of public convenience and necessity to extend, install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system for the public in areas adjacent to its existing territory all located in an unincorporated area in Franklin County, Missouri, as set forth on the map marked as **Appendix 2** and attached to this Application. The area is legally described by metes and bounds on the document marked as **Appendix 3** and attached to this Application.
- 5. In accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(A)(5), Applicant has prepared two feasibility studies which, among other things, contain plans and estimated costs of the utility plant and equipment, proposed rates and charges, and an estimate of the number of customers, revenues and expenses during the first three (3) years of operation. Said feasibility studies are marked **Appendix 4** ("Oak Hollow")and **Appendix 5** ("Bourbeuse River"), respectively, and are attached to this Application.

- 6. There are no municipalities located within the proposed area, and the approval of Franklin County is not required for Applicant to provide the sewer service provided. The issuance of construction and operating permits from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources ("Department") is subject to Commission certification inasmuch as the Commission's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity establishes the requirement of control and responsibility for the wastewater system by TBJ under Department regulations. Applicant expects that its sewer system will meet all requirements of the Department.
- 7. There are no other public utilities or governmental bodies being operated or rendering sewer service within the area proposed to be served. However, the area sought to be served is within the boundaries of Public Water Supply District No. 3 of Franklin County, Missouri. To the best of Applicant's knowledge, the appropriate point of contact at Franklin Public Water Supply District No. 3 is as follows:

8. The area requested to be certificated is comprised of approximately 1100 acres that are to be developed into a residential subdivision of lots sized of approximately one and a quarter acres. Also, the proposed area encompasses approximately 25 to 30 existing homes. Sewer service to those homes consists of septic systems and drain fields. The nature of the existing sewer treatment and opportunities for sewer treatment present the problems of operating a multitude of septic tanks with the possible negative impact on the quality of the aquifer which provides a source of drinking water to residents of the area.

In addition, the plans to develop the property for new residential home sites will increase the number of persons residing in the area who will need to be served. Therefore, public need exists for adequate sewer service within the area proposed to be served, and the public convenience and necessity will be promoted by the granting of the authority herein requested.

#### ORDER APPROVING CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

On April 8, 1997, TBJ Sewer System Inc. (TBJ) filed an application with the Commission requesting a certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing it to construct, own and operate a sewer system for the public in an unincorporated area of Franklin County, Missouri, as set out in a plat map and metes and bounds description attached to the TBJ application.

The proposed area consists of 14 current residential customers with a potential for four more, and a parochial church and school. A potential for up to 42 residential customers exists. TBJ is chiefly concerned with providing service to the church/school.

On October 6 the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation in this matter, stating that TBJ has agreed to the Staff's recommended flat rate for residential customers of \$22.00 per month and the Staff's recommended flat rate for the church/school of \$100.00 per month. The Staff notes that the flat rate will serve the church/school until it becomes necessary and feasible to install a meter at that location.

The Staff recommends approval of the application and offers the following additional recommendations, agreed to by TBJ, for consideration by the Commission:

- 1. Approve rates as described herein, to be reviewed by the Staff within eighteen (18) months of the effective date of the tariff to be filed in this case;
- Approve depreciation accrual rates as shown on Attachment
   1;
- 3. Order the company to file a complete tariff for sewer service, with the tariff to include a service area description consistent with the application and rates and rules consistent with the Staff's recommendations herein;
- 4. Order the company to keep its books and records in accordance with the <u>Uniform System of Accounts for Class C and D Sewer Utilities</u>, along with appropriate documentation as described herein; and
- 5. Make no finding that would preclude the right to consider the ratemaking treatment to be accorded any matters addressed herein, or any future expenditures by the company, in any later proceeding.

The Commission has reviewed the application and attached documentation, and the Staff financial report and recommendation, and finds no detriment to the public from issuance of the requested certificate. The Commission will approve the application and grant TBJ a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct, own, maintain and operate a sewer system for the public in the service territory as described in the application and Staff recommendation.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That a certificate of convenience and necessity is hereby issued to TBJ Sewer System Inc. to construct, own, operate and maintain a sewer system for the public in an unincorporated area of Franklin County, Missouri, as set out in the application herein.
- 2. That TBJ Sewer System Inc. will adopt the depreciation accrual rates as set out in Attachment 1 to this Report and Order.

3. That prior to commencing construction and operation, TBJ Sewer System Inc. will file a complete set of tariffs in full compliance with this order and the Staff recommendations set out herein.

4. That the Commission makes no finding regarding the rate treatment to be afforded the construction and operation of the approved sewer system and reserves all ratemaking treatment thereof for an appropriate rate proceeding.

5. That this order shall become effective on November 12, 1997.






