On April 7, 2025,¹ the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a complaint alleging that City Utilities of Springfield, Missouri (CU) violated several Commission rules relating to a gas safety incident Staff investigated in File No. GS-2024-0024, including various recommendations in its filing. On April 24, CU filed a Motion to Dismiss indicating that it believed the Commission did not have jurisdiction to rule over Staff's allegations. That same day, the Commission ordered Staff to respond. On May 15, Staff filed its response stating the Commission did have jurisdiction to rule over Staff's allegations, reiterating the allegations and its recommendations.

The Commission will order the parties to file a joint proposed procedural schedule including dates for an evidentiary hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than June 6, 2025, Staff shall file a joint proposed procedural schedule including dates for an evidentiary hearing.
