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

**ORDER SCHEDULING AN ON-THE-RECORD PRESENTATION**  
**REGARDING STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT**

On June 25, 2001, the parties appeared for hearing and announced that they have reached an agreement in principle to resolve all disputed issues in this case. The parties indicated that they will reduce their agreement to writing and will file a written stipulation and agreement on June 26. The Commission may have questions about that stipulation and agreement, and for that reason an on-the-record presentation will be scheduled.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That an on-the-record presentation regarding the stipulation and agreement filed in this case will be conducted on June 28, 2001, at 1:00 p.m.
2. That the on-the-record presentation will be held in the offices of the Missouri Public Service Commission in Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 3. That this order shall become effective on June 28, 2001.
