

ORDER AUTHORIZING TRANSFER  
OF  
BUSINESS RECORDS

By application filed October 6, 1980, Applicant, Holway Telephone  
Company (formerly The Nodaway Valley Telephone Company), seeks approval of this  
Commission for the maintenance of its books and records at the offices of its  
parent corporation, Century Telephone Enterprises, Inc., with its general office  
at:

520 Riverside Drive  
Post Office Box 4065  
Monroe, Louisiana 71203.

Upon consideration of the application and the recommendations of its  
Staff, the Commission is of the opinion that a hearing is unnecessary to resolve  
the issues presented, and finds and concludes as follows:

The Applicant is a corporation duly organized and existing under the  
laws of the State of Missouri and is engaged in the furnishing of local and long  
distance telephone service at Maitland and Skidmore, Missouri, and surrounding  
areas pursuant to certificates of convenience and necessity issued by this Commis-  
sion.

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-10.010, Applicant agrees to hold itself ready and  
willing to produce any or all of its books and records and to permit the Commis-  
sion or any of its agents to inspect any of its books and records, the same as if  
the books and records were kept within the State of Missouri. The Applicant  
further agrees to be responsible for all reasonable expenses incurred by officers  
and employees of the Commission in examining the books and records, if so ordered  
by the Commission; provided, however, that before any such expense shall be  
incurred by the Commission, the Applicant shall be given reasonable notice and  
opportunity to produce its books and records at the Commission's offices in  
Jefferson City, Missouri, or at an office of the Applicant in the State of

Missouri, or at any other point in the State of Missouri mutually agreed upon. The Applicant also consents to make available, with the books and records, a person who is acquainted with such records.

The Commission Staff has recommended approval of the authority sought, as a result of the Applicant's willingness to comply with 4 CSR 240-10.010 as previously recited herein.

In the Commission's opinion the recommendation of the Staff is reasonable and the authority herein sought should be granted, subject to the conditions recited.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That Holway Telephone Company (formerly The Nodaway Valley Telephone Company) be, and it is, hereby authorized to maintain its books and records at the offices of its parent corporation, Century Telephone Enterprises, Inc., with general offices at: 520 Riverside Drive, Post Office Box 4065, Monroe, Louisiana 71203.

ORDERED: 2. That the authority herein granted shall continue so long as the Applicant complies with 4 CSR 240-10.010.

ORDERED: 3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
