### ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE

On August 3, 2020, Benjamin J. Pick filed a motion for leave to appear *pro hac vice* as attorney for Middlefork Water Company (Middlefork). Middlefork is a joint applicant in this case. She entered her appearance in this case as local counsel for Middlefork on August 3, 2020. Mr. Pick provided proof that he has complied with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m).

The Commission has considered the petition and finds that it complies with the requirements of 20 CSR 4240-2.040(3)(C) and Missouri Supreme Court Rules 6.01(m) and 9.03. The Commission, therefore, admits Joshua Smith *pro hac vice*.
