ORDER APPROVING TRUE-UP ADJUSTMENT TARIFF

Issue Date: July 16, 2025 Effective Date: August 1, 2025

On June 13, 2025, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty submitted a revised tariff sheet for an interim true-up of its Securitized Utility Tariff Charge Rider (SUTC). That tariff sheet bears an August 1, 2025, effective date. The Commission's *Amended Report and Order* provides that, in addition to annual true-ups, the servicer may make true-up adjustments as required to correct any undercollection to assure timely payment of securitized utility tariff bonds

The Commission directed its Staff (Staff) to file a recommendation about Liberty's true-up adjustment tariff sheet and set a time for other responses. Staff filed a recommendation on July 1, 2025, stating that Staff had reviewed Liberty's workpapers for mathematical or clerical errors in the calculation of the securitized utility tariff charge and found no mathematical or clerical errors. Staff recommends that the Commission approve Liberty's true-up adjustment tariff sheet to take effect on August 1, 2025. The Commission received no other responses to Liberty's true-up adjustment tariff sheet.

The Commission reviewed the tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation and finds that the true-up adjustment tariff sheet should be approved. The Commission will approve Liberty's tariff sheet to become effective on August 1, 2025. Accordingly, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than 30 days so that the order will be effective concurrently with the tariff sheet.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following tariff sheet filed by Liberty on June 13, 2025, and assigned Tracking No. JE-2025-0176, is approved to become effective on August 1, 2025:
