**ORDER OPENING A WORKING CASE TO CONSIDER A COMMISSION
RULE REGARDING COGENERATION**

The Commission has considered an amendment to its cogeneration rule, 20 CSR 4240-20.060 in File No. EX-2020-0006, but has decided to withdraw that rulemaking to allow more time to consider various aspects of that rule, including recent guidance by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). The Commission will open this working case to review and collect comments about an appropriate amendment to its cogeneration rule. The Commission would like to proceed expeditiously with this review, but the timing and particulars of that review will be left to the discretion of the Commission's Staff.

Notice of this new working case will be provided to the participants in the previous rulemaking file and to participants in EW-2018-0078, the previous working case established to consider this rule.

This file will serve as a repository for documents and comments. Using this file, anyone with an interest in this matter may view documents and may submit any pertinent

responsive comments or documents. As this is not a contested case, anyone may file a comment without counsel and without *ex parte* constraints (arising from this matter). Intervention requests are not necessary to submit comments or view documents.


