On July 10, 2025, the parties<sup>1</sup> filed a non-unanimous *Joint Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule* (Motion). The Motion stated that the parties reached an agreement on all issues except billing determinants and rate design and are in the process of reflecting the terms of such agreement in a formal stipulation and agreement.

The Commission granted the motion to suspend the procedural schedule and delayed the hearing until August 11, 2025. The Commission will now order a status report.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties shall file a copy of any agreement reached or a status report on this matter no later than August 1, 2025.
2. This order is effective when issued.
