ORDER DIRECTING JOINT PROPOSED SCHEDULE FOR EVIDENTIARY HEARING

On September 17, 2020, Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp. applied for an accounting authority order related to COVID-19. On October 19, 2020, the Commission granted the intervention requests of Midwest Energy Consumers Group, Missouri School Boards' Association, the National Housing Trust, and Renew Missouri. On December 2, 2020, the Commission divided the original File Number, AU-2021-0072, filed by Midstates Natural Gas and several affiliate companies, and established the above File Number for Midstates Natural Gas' application only.

In order to expedite the development of a procedural schedule and in light of the current social distancing restrictions, the Commission will direct the parties to jointly propose a procedural schedule.

The Commission requests the parties include the following as part of a proposed procedural schedule leading to an evidentiary hearing:

- Submission of a Joint Stipulation of Facts;
- Submission of List of Issues and Order of Hearing Components, and
 Position Statements at least four days in advance of the hearing;

- At least one settlement conference;
- Allowance for ten business days for transcript preparation;
- An evidentiary hearing held via WebEx.

Any request for expedited hearing transcripts must be made before the procedural schedule is established.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. No later than December 23, 2020, the parties shall submit a joint proposed schedule as described in this order.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
