**ORDER FINDING COMPLIANCE**

Issue Date: December 16, 2015

Effective Date: December 29, 2015

The Commission is making its finding as to the triennial integrated resource plan ("IRP") for 2015 of Kansas City Power & Light Company ("GMO").

**Filings**

GMO filed its IRP<sup>1</sup> as required by the chapter of Commission rules on electric utility resource planning.<sup>2</sup> The Commission received a report from Staff<sup>3</sup> and comments from Natural Resources Defense Council ("NRDC"),<sup>4</sup> and Sierra Club.<sup>5</sup> GMO and Staff made a joint filing,<sup>6</sup> for which Staff also separately provided information and explanation.<sup>7</sup> In response to the Commission's schedule for further filings,<sup>8</sup> the

Commission received a further joint filing from GMO and Staff,<sup>9</sup> and further comments from NRDC,<sup>10</sup> to which GMO filed a response.<sup>11</sup>

### **Findings**

The Commission's regulations provide that the Commission will issue an order on the IRP,<sup>12</sup> and that such order may find:

That the [IRP] does . . . demonstrate compliance with the requirements of this chapter, and that the utility's resource acquisition strategy . . . does . . . meet the requirements stated in 4 CSR 240-22. [<sup>13</sup>]

The Commission will find that the IRP, and GMO's resource acquisition strategy, meet the requirements stated in 4 CSR 240-22.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. As of December 16, 2015, the *KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) Integrated Resource Plan* demonstrates compliance with the requirements of chapter 4 CSR 240-22; and KCP&L's resource acquisition strategy meets the requirements stated in 4 CSR 240-22.
