ATTACHMENT B

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

1. Dialing Parity - Section 251(b)(3)

Each Party shall provide the other Party with nondiscriminatory access to such services and information as are necessary to allow the other Party to implement local Dialing Parity in accordance with the requirements of Section 251(b)(3) of the Act.

2. Directory Listing and Directory Distribution

BPS will provide directory listing services to Big River. Big River will receive for its retail end users, one primary listing in BPS' White Pages Directory and a listing in BPS' directory listing data base. Such services will be provided in accordance with the terms set forth herein.

2.1 Listing Information

As used herein, "Listing Information" means a Customer's primary name, address (including city, state and zip code), telephone number(s), the delivery address and number of directories to be delivered, and, in the case of a business Customer, the primary business heading under which the business Customer desires to be placed, and any other information both parties agree to be included in the publication and delivery of directories.

2.2 Listing Information Supply

- 2.2.1 Big River shall provide to BPS on a regularly scheduled basis, at no charge, and in a format mutually agreed upon, all Listing Information and the service address for each Big River Customer whose service address location falls within the geographic area covered by the BPS directory or who has subscribed to foreign exchange service for the geographic area covered by the BPS directory. Big River shall also provide to BPS on a daily basis, (a) information showing BPS Customers who have disconnected or terminated their service with Big River; and (b) delivery information for each non-listed or non-published Big River Customer to enable BPS to perform its directory distribution responsibilities.
- 2.2.2 The foregoing notwithstanding, Big River will not provide directory Listing Information to BPS for non-published telephone numbers. Big River understands that BPS will have no ability to provide such unlisted directory Listing Information to any third parties and BPS may not deliver published directories to Big River's Customers with non-published telephone numbers.

2.3 Listing Inclusion and Distribution

BPS shall include, on a nondiscriminatory basis and consistent with any obligations it may have under Applicable Law, at no charge, each Big River Customer's Primary Listing in all appropriate alphabetical directories (both print and electronic) and, for

business Customers, in the appropriate classified (Yellow Pages) directories in accordance with the directory configuration, scope and schedules determined by BPS in its sole discretion, and shall provide initial distribution of such directories to such Big River Customers in the same manner it provides initial distribution of such directories to its own Customers. "Primary Listing" means a Customer's primary name, address, and telephone number. Listings of Big River's Customers shall be interfiled with listings of BPS' Customers and the Customers of other LECs included in the BPS directories. Big River shall pay the charges set forth in the Pricing Attachment for any additional alphabetical listings and other alphabetical services (e.g. caption arrangements) for Big River's Customers. BPS will not require a minimum number of listings per order.

2.4 BPS Information

Upon request by Big River, BPS shall make available to Big River the following information to the extent that BPS provides such information to its own business offices: a directory list of relevant NXX codes, directory close dates, publishing data, and Yellow Pages headings. BPS also will make available to Big River, upon written request, a copy of BPS' alphabetical listings standards and specifications manual.

2.5 Confidentiality of Listing Information

BPS shall accord Big River Listing Information the same level of confidentiality that BPS accords its own listing information, and shall use such Listing Information solely for the purpose of providing directory-related services; provided, however, it may not use or license Big River Listing Information for directory publishing by third parties or any other purpose beyond the purposes specifically outlined in this Section 2 without the written permission of Big River.

2.6 Accuracy

Both Parties shall use commercially reasonable efforts to ensure the accurate publication of Big River Customer listings. At Big River's request, BPS shall provide Big River with a report, in a format specified by BPS, of all Big River's Customer listings normally no more than ninety (90) days and no less than thirty (30) days prior to the service order close date for the applicable directory. BPS shall process any corrections made by Big River with respect to its listings, provided such corrections are received prior to the close date of the particular directory. Big River shall pay BPS for the listing reports at the rates set forth in the Pricing Attachment.

2.7 Indemnification

Big River shall adhere to all practices, standards, and ethical requirements established by BPS with regard to listings. By providing BPS with Listing Information, Big River represents to BPS that Big River has the right to provide such Listing Information to BPS on behalf of its Customers for publishing in BPS' directories provided to the public. Big River agrees to release, defend, hold harmless and indemnify BPS from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, suits, or other actions, or any liability whatsoever, suffered, made, instituted, or asserted by any person arising out of BPS' publication or dissemination of the Listing Information as provided by Big River hereunder.

2.8 Liability

BPS' liability to Big River in the event of a BPS error in or omission of a listing shall not exceed the lesser of the amount of charges actually paid by Big River for such listing or the amount by which BPS would be liable to its own Customer.

2.9 Directory Publication

Nothing in this Agreement shall require BPS to publish a directory where it would not otherwise do so.

3. Intercept and Referral Announcements

- 3.1 When a Customer changes its service provider from BPS to Big River, or from Big River to BPS, and does not retain its original telephone number, the Party formerly providing service to such Customer shall provide a referral announcement ("Referral Announcement") on the abandoned telephone number which provides the Customer's new number or other appropriate information, to the extent known to the Party formerly providing service. Notwithstanding the foregoing, a Party shall not be obligated under this Section to provide a Referral Announcement if the Customer owes the Party unpaid overdue amounts or the Customer requests that no Referral Announcement be provided.
- 3.2 Referral Announcements shall be provided for a period of time for business Customers and residential Customers in accordance with the same time period and terms specified in BPS' tariff and/or pursuant to BPS' general business practices. Except as otherwise provided by Applicable Law, the period for a referral may be shortened by the Party formerly providing service if a number shortage condition requires reassignment of the telephone number. This referral announcement will be provided by each Party at no charge to the other Party; provided that the Party formerly providing service may bill the Customer its standard Tariff charge, if any, for the referral announcement.

4. Resale of Retail Telecommunications Services

4.1 General Requirements

- 4.1.1 At the request of Big River, and pursuant to the requirements of the Act, any telecommunications service that BPS currently provides or hereafter provides at retail to subscribers who are not telecommunications carriers will be made available to Big River by BPS in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Section.
- 4.1.2 The Parties agree that a LEC has the duty not to prohibit, and not to impose unreasonable or discriminatory conditions or limitations on, the resale of its telecommunication service pursuant to 251(b)(1) of the Act.
- 4.1.3 BPS will apply an End User Common Line (EUCL) charge to each local exchange line resold under this agreement. All federal rules and regulations associated with EUCL charges, as found in BPS FCC Tariff, also apply.

- 4.1.4 BPS will make available to Big River, including but not limited to for resale the following BPS services at BPS' tariffed rate for each service (or in the event a service is not tariffed, at the rate BPS charges its subscribers, except as otherwise provided herein):
 - Construction Charges
 - Connections with Terminal Equipment and Communications Systems
 - Maintenance of Service Charges
 - Suspension Services/Restoral Services
 - Access Services
- 4.1.5 Telecommunications Services will be resold by BPS to Big River on terms and conditions that are reasonable and nondiscriminatory.

4.1.6 <u>Directory Assistance and Operator Services</u>

Subject to any blocking that may be ordered by Big River for its customers, to the extent Directory Assistance (DA) services are provided to BPS' customers, BPS shall provide Big River's customers access to BPS' Directory Assistance services.

Subject to any blocking that may be ordered by Big River for its customers, BPS will provide access to Operator Services ("OS") to BPS' customers to the same extent it provides OS to its own customers.

4.1.7 Directory Listings Requirements

BPS shall provide Big River's customers access to BPS' Directory Listing services.

- 4.1.8 Unless otherwise provided in this Agreement, BPS will perform all of its obligations hereunder throughout the entire service area where BPS is the incumbent local exchange carrier. BPS will provide the services covered by this Attachment subject to the availability of facilities in this state.
- 4.1.9 Big River may at any time add or delete features to or relocate the Resale services for Big River's customers except for grandfathered services. However, Big River may only offer grandfathered services to customers that are eligible to receive grandfathered services from BPS.
- 4.1.10 Big River may terminate any Resale service within the period specified for termination of such Resale service in BPS' tariff applicable to that service, unless a different period is specified in this Section.

4.2 Pricing

Service provided under the Resale arrangement as outlined in this Section 4, will be priced at a 19% discount to BPS' tariffed rates.
