ORDER CHANGING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This order grants the motion of the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission for an extension of time and revises the procedural schedule.

On April 10, 2001, the Commission adopted the proposed procedural schedule of the parties that included a deadline of December 4, 2001, for the filing of Staff's recommendation. On November 21, 2001, Staff filed a motion for an extension of time stating that because of difficulties in contracting with a consultant, Staff would be unable to comply with the deadline for filing its recommendation. Staff requested that it be granted until January 18, 2002, to file its recommendation.

On November 27, 2001, the Commission issued an order directing Staff to file a proposed procedural schedule reflecting the effects of an extension of time. The Commission also ordered that any responses to Staff's motion should be filed no later than November 29, 2001. Staff filed a proposed revised procedural schedule on November 29, 2001.

Staff stated in its Proposed Revised Procedural Schedule that "Greeley [Gas Company] and the Office of the Public Counsel have reviewed the proposed revised dates and have expressed their agreement with them." Greeley filed a response on

November 29, 2001, stating that it was not opposed to Staff's proposal. There were no objections to the proposed revisions.

The Commission has reviewed Staff proposed revised procedural schedule and finds it to be reasonable. Therefore, the Commission will adopt the proposed revised procedural schedule as set out below.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Motion for Extension of Time and for Expedited Treatment filed by the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission on November 21, 2001, is granted.
- 2. That the procedural schedule shall be revised according to the Proposed Revised Procedural Schedule filed on November 29, 2001. The following procedural schedule is adopted:
