ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a recommendation regarding The Empire District Electric Company's application for approval of a portfolio of transportation electrification pilot programs and accounting treatment. Staff's filing indicated concerns with the sample proposed tariff sheets. Staff also expressed concern with establishing rates for the sale of electricity outside of a general rate proceeding. Staff recommends the Commission issue an order directing the parties to develop a procedural schedule with time for stakeholder participation.

Public Counsel filed a response to Staff's recommendation supporting the development of a procedural schedule.

The Commission will order Staff to consult with other parties and to file a procedural schedule on behalf of the parties.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. After consulting with all parties, Staff shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than February 9, 2021.
