ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Issue Date: January 26, 2021

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a recommendation regarding The Empire District Electric Company's application for approval of a portfolio of transportation electrification pilot programs and accounting treatment. Staff's filing indicated concerns with the sample proposed tariff sheets.¹ Staff also expressed concern with establishing rates for the sale of electricity outside of a general rate proceeding. Staff recommends the Commission issue an order directing the parties to develop a procedural schedule with time for stakeholder participation.

Public Counsel filed a response to Staff's recommendation supporting the development of a procedural schedule.

The Commission will order Staff to consult with other parties and to file a procedural schedule on behalf of the parties.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. After consulting with all parties, Staff shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than February 9, 2021.
2. This order is effective when issued.
