# SUBMISSION OF QUARTERLY REPORT UNDER ¶ 5.d OF STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or "Company"), and pursuant to ¶ 5.d of the October 1, 2024, Stipulation and Agreement filed in this case and approved by the Commission, hereby submits its Quarterly Progress Report for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2025, as follows:

Earthwork and site grading continued while pile driving was completed for Unit 1, Unit 2, and Unit 3 CTG areas only. Unit 1 and Unit 2 and Unit 3 exhaust stack piles were completed. Unit 4 was put on hold while EPC began driving piles for the fuel oil tanks (See Exhibit A, Construction Schedule, attached). See attached update Exhibit B for the current status of permitting efforts. See below for specific activities completed and plans/specifications received in Q3 2025:

#### September 2025

- EPC continued with earthwork and grading
- EPC completed pile installations at CTG Unit 3
- EPC completed pile installations at Exhaust Stack Unit 1, Unit 2, and Unit 3
- EPC completed pile installations at Fuel Oil Tank B
- EPC began HDPE pipe welding/fusing for storm sewer piping
- St. Louis County Land Disturbance permit pending, awaiting final MSD permit. Additional discussions planned with MSD.

#### August 2025

- EPC pile installations at CTG Unit 1 and Unit 2
- EPC began layout for underground conduit installation at CTG Unit 1
- EPC placed CTG Unit 1 mud matt
- EPC began pile installations for CTG Unit 3 and Unit 4
- EPC resubmitted Side Development Plan after comments received from St. Louis County

• EPC received final drawings for medium voltage switchgear

#### **July 2025**

- EPC completed soil improvements at CTG areas
- EPC submitted Site Development Plan and Land Disturbance permit to St. Louis County
- EPC completed temporary stormwater treatment system installation
- EPC placed orders for iso-phase bus
- EPC received all piles for project
