A) Does AmerenUE agree that the amounts stated by Mr. Selecky are accurate within about 10% of the actual amounts received? If not, what amounts does AmerenUE claim these amounts should be? B) What was the reason Westinghouse made the \$10 million cash payment, (or UE claimed amount), and what AmerenUE operating or plant account(s) were these funds associated with? C) What was the reason Westinghouse applied the \$5 million credit payment, (or UE claimed amount), and what AmerenUE operating or plant account(s) were these funds associated with?
