**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO APPEAR *PRO HAC VICE* AND
FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

Christine Prorok, counsel for Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI), hereby files this motion with the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri (PSC or Commission) for leave to appear as attorney *pro hac vice* in the above-referenced matter pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.040(3)(C) and 20 CSR 4240-2.080(14) and in conformance with the Missouri Supreme Court Rules 6.01(m) and 9.03. In support of this Motion, counsel states as follows:

1. I am an attorney at Whitt Sturtevant LLP, 180 North LaSalle Street, Suite 2020, Chicago, Illinois 60601.
2. I was admitted to the Bar of the State of Illinois in 2017 (registration no. 6327462), and I am a member in good standing.
3. I am also a member in good standing of the U.S. District Court of Illinois, Northern District. I am not under suspension or disbarment from any bar. Neither myself nor any member of Whitt Sturtevant is disqualified to appear in Illinois.
