7 Q. Please state your name and business address.

8 A. My name is Justin Tevie and my business address is P.O. Box 360,
9 Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.

10 Q. Are you the same Justin Tevie who provided direct testimony in this matter,
11 filed July 2, 2025?

12 A. Yes.

13 Q. What is the purpose of your rebuttal testimony?

14 A. To address Empire’s lack of information on the economic development rider
15 (“EDR”) as required in 393.1640.1.(2).

16 Q. What does sub-section 393.1640.1.(2) say?

17 A. It says, in part, the following:

18 Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this subsection,
19 the cents-per-kilowatt-hour realization resulting from application of any
20 discounted rates as calculated shall be higher than the electrical
21 corporation’s variable cost to serve such incremental demand and the
22 applicable discounted rate also shall make a positive contribution to
23 fixed costs associated with service to such incremental demand. If in a
24 subsequent general rate proceeding the commission determines that
25 application of a discounted rate is not adequate to cover the electrical
26 corporation's variable cost to serve the accounts in question and provide
27 a positive contribution to fixed costs then the commission shall increase
28 the rate for those accounts prospectively to the extent necessary to do so.

Rebuttal Testimony of
Justin Tevie

1 Q. Has Empire provided any analysis that demonstrates that each of the customers
2 receiving an EDR discount continues to pay rates that are “adequate to cover the electrical
3 corporation's variable cost to serve the accounts in question and provide a positive contribution
4 to fixed costs?

5 A. Empire has not yet provided any information on this subject. Staff is awaiting
6 Empire’s response to Staff Data Request 0449 which is due on August 19, 2025. Based upon
7 a preliminary review of a portion of the variable costs to serve the EDR customers, it appears
8 that there may be an EDR discounted rate that is not adequate to cover the electrical
9 corporation's variable cost to serve the accounts. Staff will update its position in the
10 surrebuttal and true-up round of testimony when more information is available.

11 Q. What do you recommend?

12 A. If the application of a discounted rate is not adequate to cover the electrical
13 corporation's variable cost to serve the accounts in question and provide a positive contribution
14 to fixed costs, Staff will recommend modification in a subsequent round of testimony.

15 Q. Does this conclude your rebuttal testimony?

16 A. Yes it does.



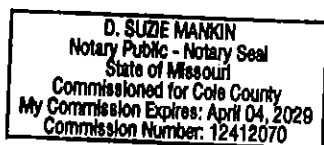


