ORDER AND NOTICE

On June 8, 1999, Warren County Sewer Co., Inc., (Applicant) filed an application with the Commission requesting issuance of a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage, and maintain a sewer system for the public in an unincorporated area in Warren County, Missouri, known as Oak Grove Subdivision. A map of the proposed area is attached to the application, together with a metes and bounds description.

Applicant is a Missouri corporation, with its principal office and place of business located at 20 Oak Street, Washington, Missouri 63090. Applicant also filed a feasibility study for the proposed sewer operation and stated in its application that there is no other sewer service or governmental body operating, providing, or rendering service in the proposed service area.

Information provided by Applicant showed that the area proposed for certification presently serves 33 mobile home residents. The

Applicant provided a list of the names and addresses of 10 residents in the proposed service area.

Proper parties should be given the opportunity to intervene. The Commission has determined that a copy of this order shall be sent to the residents listed in the application. In addition, the information officer of the Commission will send a notice of this application to each newspaper located in Warren County, Missouri, as listed in the newspaper directory of the current Official Manual of the State of Missouri, and to all members of the Missouri General Assembly representing Warren County. Further, the Records Department of the Commission shall serve a copy of this order on the County Commissioners of Warren County.

The requirement of a hearing has been fulfilled when all those having a desire to be heard are offered an opportunity to be heard. If no proper party or governmental entity is granted intervention and neither the Commission's Staff nor the Office of the Public Counsel requests a hearing, the Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary and that the Applicant may submit its evidence in support of the Application by verified statement. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. P.S.C., 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Records Department of the Missouri Public Service Commission is ordered to serve notice as set out herein.
2. That the information officer of the Missouri Public Service Commission is ordered to serve notice as set out herein.

3. That any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than July 14, 1999. Such applications shall be filed with:
