ORDER APPROVING TARIFF AND CLOSING CASE

On June 8, 1999, Warren County Sewer Co., Inc. (Applicant), filed an application with the Commission requesting issuance of a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage, and maintain a sewer system for the public in an unincorporated area in Warren County, Missouri, known as Oak Grove Subdivision. An order granting this certificate issued on November 4, 1999. The Applicant was ordered to file a tariff consistent with the order granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. On December 1, 1999, the Applicant filed its tariff with an effective date of December 31, 1999. On December 10, 1999, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its recommendation stating that the tariff complies with the terms of the Commission's November 4, 1999, order and recommending that the Commission approve PSC MO No. 1, Original Sheets Nos. 1 through 27, to become effective on December 31, 1999.

The Commission finds that the tariff complies with the Commission's order and may be approved. The tariff may be reviewed in

eighteen months pursuant to the Commission's order of November 4, 1999. No further action is required in this case at this time, and this case may be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff filed by Warren County Sewer Co., Inc., on December 1, 1999, tariff file number 200000518, is approved to become effective on December 31, 1999. The tariff approved is:
