## STAFF MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") and respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On April 2, 2001, the Commission issued its Order Adopting Procedural Schedule in the above-styled case.
- 2. All parties have complied with the procedural schedule prior to the March 20, 2002 filing date of this Motion.
- 3. Substantial changes have occurred which affect Staff's ability to timely comply with the remainder of the procedural schedules in the above-styled cases. These changes include: departure of experienced Staff who were involved in Actual Cost Adjustment cases; necessary training time for new Staff; a delay in the contract with a consultant on hedging and in providing information to that consultant; Staff time for multiple priorities including working on and with EFIS preparation, rate cases, testimony and hearings for other ACA cases, meetings and hearings on incentive plans, responding to Company Data Requests, as well as participation in Commission task forces.
- 4. All of these factors have combined to make it extremely difficult for Staff to complete audits within the existing procedural schedule, and for this reason Staff is requesting a revised Procedural Schedule.
