The Missouri Public Service Commission is directing Staff to file a response to the *Motion to Quash Notice of Deposition and to Quash Subpoena Duces Tecum and for Protective Order* ("motion"). Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("movants") filed the motion on September 27. ¹ In the motion, movants address the notice of deposition ("notice") and subpoena duces tecum ("subpoena") served on Melissa Hardesty.

The notice and subpoena require Ms. Hardesty to appear on October 1 at 9:00 a.m. with certain documents. Movants ask the Commission to quash, and issue a protective order addressing, the notice and subpoena. Movants' supporting arguments include citations to Commission orders dated April 26 and August 30. Under those orders, movants argue, Staff have waived any challenge to the sufficiency of objections already made to discovery of the subpoenaed documents.

Therefore, the Commission will order Staff to file an expedited response to the motion, which shall address the waiver argument and may address the other arguments of movants.
