ORDER APPROVING INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

Issue Date: March 3, 2021

Effective Date: April 2, 2021

This order approves an Interconnection Agreement between the parties filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri (AT&T Missouri).

On January 20, 2021, AT&T Missouri filed an application with the Commission for approval of an adoption of the Interconnection Agreement between itself and Windstream KDL, LLC (Windstream KDL) under the provisions of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. AT&T Missouri is certificated with the Commission as an incumbent local exchange carrier and is a registered IVoIP provider. Windstream KDL is certificated with the Commission as a competitive local exchange and interexchange carrier..

Although Windstream KDL is a party to the Agreement, it did not join in the application. On January 25, 2021, the Commission issued an order making Windstream KDL a party in this case and directing any party wishing to request a hearing to do so no later than February 9, 2021. No requests for hearing were filed.

Under Section 252(e) of the Act, any Interconnection Agreement adopted by negotiation must be submitted to the Commission for approval. The Commission may reject an Agreement if it finds that the Agreement is discriminatory or that it is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

On February 23, 2021, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation. Staff recommends that the Agreement be approved and notes that the Agreement meets the limited requirements of the Act in that it is not discriminatory toward nonparties and is not against the public interest.

The Commission has considered the application, the supporting documentation, and Staff's recommendation. Based upon that review, the Commission finds that the Agreement meets the requirements of the Act in that it does not discriminate against a nonparty carrier and implementation of the Agreement is not inconsistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Interconnection Agreement between AT&T Missouri and Windstream KDL, filed on January 20, 2021, is approved.
2. This order shall become effective on April 2, 2021.
3. This file may be closed on April 3, 2021.
