Dear Ms. Dippell:

Pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-20.093(4) of the regulations of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission” or “MPSC”), Evergy Missouri West, Inc. or the “Company” submitted a proposed rate schedule to adjust charges related to the Company’s approved Demand Side Investment Mechanism (“DSIM”) Rider on December 1, 2025.

This filing included additional Cycle 3 Original Sheet No. 138.19.1 because the Cycle 3 Original Sheet No. 138.20 approved in Case No. EO-2019-0132 was inadvertently cancelled due to Cycle 4 1st Revised Sheet No. 138.20 approved in Case No. EO-2023-0370. To correct this, Cycle 3 138.19.1 was added to this filing with an issue date of December 1, 2025 and an effective date of February 1, 2026.

During their review, Staff found another Cycle 3 tariff reference to correct. This substitute filing is providing Cycle 3 3rd Revised Sheet No. 138.10 updated in the fifth paragraph to reference to Sheet No. 138.19.1 mentioned above.

**Re: Tariff Schedule to Adjust Demand Side Investment Mechanism Rider
Rate of Evergy Missouri West**

Dear Ms. Dippell:

Pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-20.093(4) of the regulations of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission" or "MPSC"), Evergy Missouri West, Inc. or the "Company" hereby submits a proposed rate schedule to adjust charges related to the Company's approved Demand Side Investment Mechanism ("DSIM") Rider. The proposed rate schedule bears an issue date of December 1, 2025, and an effective date of February 1, 2026.

The DSIM rate components included in this filing consist of:

- Cycle 4 – Projected Program Costs ("PC") and Throughput Disincentive ("TD") for the period of November 2025 through December 2026 and a reconciliation of actual and expected PC and TD through October 2025, with interest.
- Cycle 3 - Projected TD for the period of November 2025 through December 2026 and a reconciliation of actual and expected PC, TD, Earnings Opportunity ("EO") and Ordered Adjustments ("OA") through October 2025, with interest.
- Cycle 2 - A reconciliation of actual and expected TD and EO through October 2025, with interest.
- Cycle 3 EO 1) including TD adjustments based on verified MWh savings for the 2022 program year and 2) based on actual program cost spend for the 2024 program year.

These amounts are divided by the projected retail sales, excluding opt-out sales, by rate class for the period of February 2026 through January 2027, to develop the proposed DSIM rates.

Please see the table below for the proposed change in rates.

As explained in the Direct Testimony and supporting schedules of Leigh Anne Jones, which are submitted concurrently herewith, the overall DSIM rate reflects progress towards achievement of energy and demand savings originally established in the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (“MEEIA”) filing made in File No. EO-2012-0009 and updated in File Nos. EO-2015-0241, EO-2019-0132 and EO-2023-0370. Also provided herewith are schedules containing the information required by 20 CSR 4240-20.093(4) including all work papers that support the proposed rate schedule.

Additional tariffs included in this filing consist of:

- Cycle 2 tariffs: Sheet No. 138 through Sheet No. 138.8 have been added to this filing. As these are no longer applicable, they have been updated to “Reserved for Future Use” with an issue date of December 1, 2025 and an effective date of February 1, 2026.
- Cycle 3 Original Sheet No. 138.20 was issued on December 1, 2023 and effective January 1, 2024 in Case No. EO-2019-0132. However this tariff sheet was inadvertently cancelled due to Cycle 4 1st Revised Sheet No. 138.20 issued on October 15, 2024 and effective January 1, 2025 in Case No. EO-2023-0370. To correct this, Cycle 3 Original Sheet No. 138.19.1 has been added to this filing with an issue date of December 1, 2025 and an effective date of February 1, 2026.
- Cycle 3 3rd Revised Sheet No. 138.16 was updated in the third paragraph to reference to Sheet No. 138.19.1 mentioned above.
