RESPONSE TO STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Company" or "Ameren Missouri"), and for its response to the Staff's November 24, 2025, Recommendation in this case, states as follows:

- 1. The Staff Recommendation reflects the Staff's conclusion that the Program Phase No. 3 tariff sheet, filed November 12, 2025, complies with the applicable Commission orders and recommends that it be approved. The Staff, however, seeks an order suspending the tariff (which bears an effective date of December 12, 2025) based on various grounds stated in the Staff Recommendation.
- 2. While the Company does not agree with the Staff's rationale for suspending the tariff, the Company will, in the next few days, provide the Staff documentation demonstrating that the Vandalia solar facility has met the agreed-upon in-service criteria (expected to be provided no later than December 9, 2025). This should resolve the issues Staff raises in the near-term and allow subscribers to be charged under the Program based *only* on the output of the Vandalia facility. For clarity, no charges associated with the other facility that will ultimately also apply to Program Phase No. 3 subscribers (the Bowling Green facility) will be assessed to subscribers until such time as the Bowling Green facility is fully operational and used for service.
 - 3. To allow the Staff time to review the documentation, the Company has, today,

extended the tariff effective date to December 19, 2025.² There is, therefore, no need for any order from the Commission suspending the tariff. While the Company expects that the Staff can complete its review in advance of the extended effective date of December 19, 2025, should the Staff require additional time, the Company would be agreeable to a further modest extension of the tariff effective date.

4. Based on the foregoing, the Company requests that the Commission make no order respecting the tariff at this time and commits to making a further filing in this docket by December 17, 2025, respecting the Staff's review.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri submits this response to the Staff Recommendation.
