STAFF NOTICE

COMES NOW, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through counsel, and hereby submits *Staff Notice*, and states as follows:

1. On November 20, 2025, EM3 Networks LLC submitted a request to recognize its name change to Capcon Networks LLC.¹
2. The Commission granted EM3 Networks, LLC. authority to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol (IVoIP) services effective June 15, 2017.²
3. Rule 20 CSR 4240-28.011 (2) requires any “company with a certificate or registration that changes its name shall provide advance notice to the commission of the name change.”
4. Notice may be in the form of a letter signed by a company official submitted into Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) as a new case submission containing the following information: the new name of the company and date the new name takes effect; documentation that the new name is registered with the Missouri Secretary of State; and a statement the company has reviewed and, if necessary, updated the company's contacts in EFIS.³

The Commission issued an *Order* recognizing the name change with an effective date of December 12, 2025, and ordered the case closed on December 13, 2025.⁴ However, Staff has reviewed the application for name change and found that EM3 Networks LLC., and/or Capcon Networks LLC., failed to submit documentation that the new name is registered with the Missouri Secretary of State; and failed to submit a statement the company has reviewed and, if necessary, updated the company's contacts in EFIS.

6. Staff reached out to EM3 Networks LLC., and/or Capcon Networks LLC., notifying it of the deficiencies in its application and requesting the company submit supplemental filings. However, as of the date of this filing, the company has not submitted the additional filings for its application. Staff requests that the Commission suspend its *Order* recognizing the name change and order EM3 Networks LLC., and/or Capcon Networks LLC to correct the company's deficiencies with its filing.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully submits this *Staff* Notice and request that the Commission suspend its order and direct EM3 Networks LLC., and/or Capcon Networks LLC to submit its supplemental filings in accordance with Rule 20 CSR 4240-28.011 (2); and to grant such other and further relief as the Commission considers just and reasonable in the circumstances.
