## ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

Issue Date: December 11, 2025 Effective Date: December 11, 2025

On October 10, 2025, the Commission issued its *Report and Order* denying Cheri Meadows' complaint. That order became effective on November 28, 2025. Meadows filed a timely application for rehearing on November 27, 2025.

Along with the application for rehearing, Meadows asks the Commission to consider new evidence concerning whether another landowner was willing to have the Grain Belt Express transmission line traverse their property instead of hers. As footnoted on page 5 of the Report and Order: "The case is considered submitted as of the date of the final brief pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.150(1)." Reply briefs were filed on September 25, 2025. The Commission will not reopen the record to consider new evidence that is not relevant to whether Grain Belt Express fell short of a required safety standard or violated a provision of law subject to the Commission's authority, a rule promulgated by the Commission, a utility tariff, or any order or decision of the Commission.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo., states that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." In the judgment of the Commission, Meadows' application for rehearing does not demonstrate sufficient reason to rehear this matter.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Meadows' application for rehearing is denied.
- 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
