## **Response:**

No, the "old" AMI meters that are being replaced currently don't have remote disconnect capability. However, during our original deployments there were some SD meters installed on commercial accounts, high move-in/out locations, and the rural areas of the territory. Currently EMM has approximately 179,000 SD meters and EMW has 188,887 SD Meters.
